THE TRIPLE CROWN

The Triple Crown of Thoroughbred Racing is a series of horse races for three-year-old Thoroughbreds. There are three races that make up the Triple Crown. The first is the Kentucky Derby at Churchill Downs in Louisville, Kentucky, also known as "The Run for the Roses." Next is the Preakness Stakes, or "The Run for the Black-Eyed Susans," held at Pimlico Race Course in Baltimore, Maryland. And the last race, the Belmont Stakes or "*The Test of The Champion*," is held at Belmont Park in Elmont, New York.

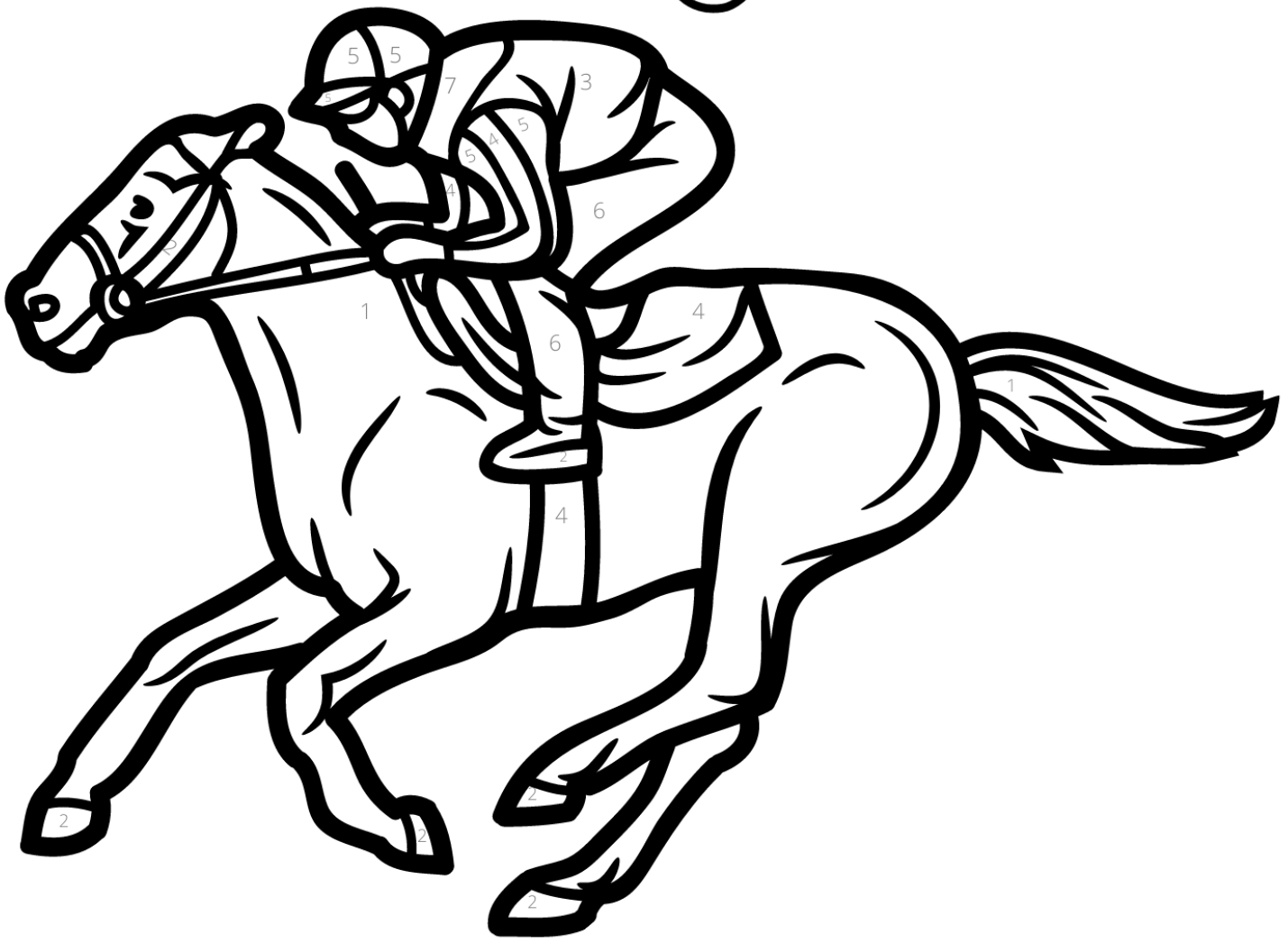

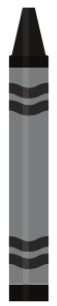

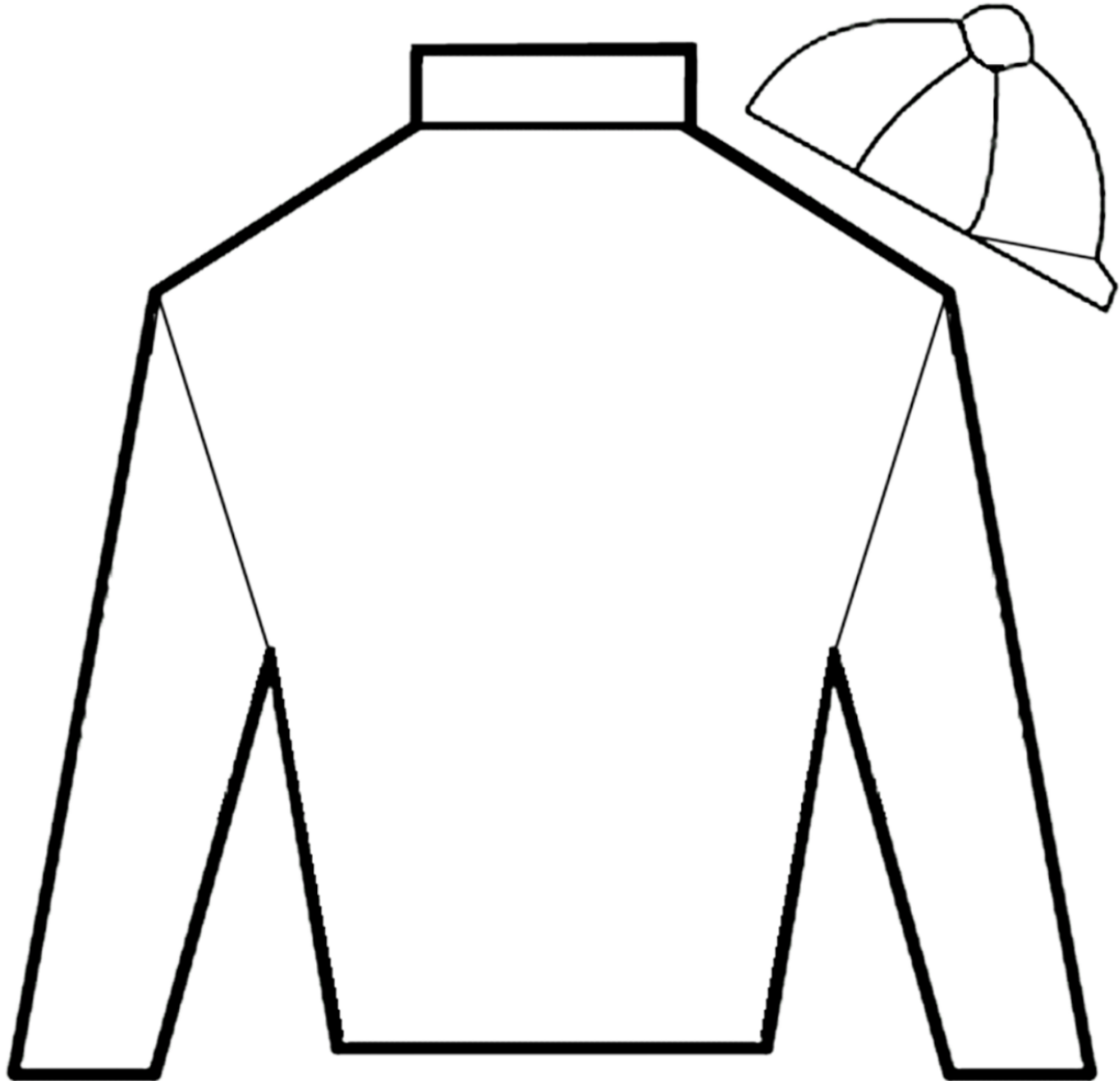
